

Your Research Intent

All applicants must identify a topic of research from the inter-disciplinary range of themes including Natural Resource Management; Business and Economics; Marine Ecology and Ocean Science; Food Systems; Renewable Energy; Food and Water Security; Waste Management; Public Health and Sustainable Development.

Your Research Intent should be less than 1,000 and include the following elements:

1. **Introduction:** Overview of the research topic.
2. **Context:** Background and relevance of the research.
3. **Objectives:** Specific goals and expected outcomes.
4. **Methodology:** Approach and techniques for conducting the research.
5. **Significance:** Importance and potential impact of the research

Note:

At the research intent stage, detailed information on **Logistics, Timeline, and Bibliography** is not required. These aspects will be thoroughly addressed in your comprehensive research proposal.
