Your Research Intent

Both PhD and Master's scholarship applicants must identify a research topic from a broad range of interdisciplinary themes, including Natural Resource Management, Business and Economics, Marine Ecology and Ocean Science, Food Systems, Renewable Energy, Food and Water Security, Waste Management, Public Health, Public Policy, and Sustainable Development.

Your Research Intent should be less than 1,000 and include the following elements:

- 1. **Research Topic:** Proposed research topic (less than 50 words).
- 2. **Introduction:** Overview of the research topic.
- 3. **Context:** Background and relevance of the research.
- 4. **Objectives:** Specific goals and expected outcomes.
- 5. **Methodology:** Approach and techniques for conducting the research.
- 6. **Significance:** Importance and potential impact of the research

Note:

At the research intent stage, detailed information on **Logistics, Timeline**, and **Bibliography** is not required. These aspects will be thoroughly addressed in your comprehensive research proposal.
